

(The Ultimate) Vehicle Emergency Kit

Use a clear tote with a lid to store your emergency kit safely in your vehicle.

Pro tip: Include this checklist in your tote!

- Safety Vest
- Road Flares/Reflective Triangles
- Fire Extinguisher
- First Aid Kit
- Basic Tool Kit
- Flashlight (with extra batteries!)
- Battery-Powered Radio
- Tire Sealant (like Fix-A-Flat)
- Jumper Cables
- Tow Strap
- Cat Litter/Sand
- Portable/Foldable Shovel
- Rain Poncho/Raincoat
- Extra hats, gloves, socks, jackets for each potential vehicle occupant
- Blankets (or emergency blankets)
- Hand/Foot Warmers (like HotHands)
- Non-perishable snacks and bottled water
 - Dog food - if you regularly travel with a canine companion!
- Snow Brush + Ice Scraper
- Pen + Paper
- Extra Phone Charger*

*Cell phones will dial 911 even if they are not connected to a wireless carrier. Keep an old phone charged (and off) in your kit in case your phone loses charge or is damaged!
